- We feel disappointed in not being able to visit the churches and supporters we had scheduled to visit during these months. - We are also concerned for the **ministries in Brazil** during this challenging time. We made the difficult decision to **lay off** all but one of our staff at the ARCA Bible Camp because of lack of rentals and funds to keep going. In Brazil it is very costly to lay off workers as there is severance pay and government taxes to pay for each one. We needed to pay about \$10,000 to do this. We still **need funds** to keep the place functioning until we can start up again.
- Churches around the world are facing hard decisions about how to continue ministering to people. Schools and businesses are struggling to stay solvent. Families are suffering the effects of unemployment. Everyone wonders what tomorrow will bring. It's so good to know that through it all, **God is faithful** and unchanging. We can trust in Him.
